EVALUATION:

The final mark will be decided upon by the instructor and will be based on the quality of the written works. The components that will be taken into account will include the handling of basic skills (i.e. harmony, counterpoint, orchestration), extended forms and textures, as well as musicality, discerning ear, originality, creative thinking and logic.

There will be no Christmas or final exam.

Please note that prerequisites are no longer' automatically checked prior to course registration, It is the responsibility of each student to ensure that he or she has the specified prerequisites.

Unless you either have the requisites for this course or special permission from the Dean to enroll in it, you will be removed from the courses and it will be deleted from your record.

This decision may not be appealed.

You will receive no adjustment to your fees in the event that you are dropped from a course for failing to have the necessary prerequisites.
