Doctoral Research Fund Application (for PhD and DMA students in Music only)

The Doctoral Research Fund is available to senior doctoral students in Music to support thesis research toward a PhD Dissertation or a DMA Monograph. The availability of this fund must be approved each year.

Students may apply for support in the form of reimbursement of expenses for research travel or other expenses (such as rare scores or books unavailable through library resources) that are directly related to the execution of dissertation or monograph research.

Your dissertation or monograph proposal need not have received formal approval by the Graduate Committee when you apply, but you must make clear how the proposed project will facilitate the completion of your PhD dissertation or DMA monograph. We may contact your supervisor for further information.

There is no maximum amount of funding for which you can apply. Please submit a budget that reflects the full cost of your proposal, and you will be considered for partial if not full funding.

If you are unsure about whether your project is eligible for support from the Doctoral Research Fund, you are welcome to contact the Associate Dean (Graduate Studies) to ask for clarification.
