Year 1 M1140, M1925

Repertoire shall be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List in consultation with the studio teacher to ensure an appropriate level of difficulty. Substitutions are permitted with the instructor's permission. Two or three pieces should be selected to contrast in style, and must amount to a total playing time of not less than 15 minutes. Scales and etudes will not be required for juries, although they will be studied in lessons, and must be included in the student's daily practice routine. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 1 M1920

In consultation with the studio teacher, students must prepare 3 pieces of repertoire – at least one piece from the following list of Required Works, and the others may be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List. Substitutions are permitted with the instructor's permission. All selected repertoire must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes.

Scales and etudes will not be required for juries. Students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical Evaluations will take place according to the regimen detailed in the Syllabus, under "Technique Evaluation". It is expected that scales and etudes will be an integral part of each student's practice routine, and technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 2 M2925

Repertoire shall be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List in consultation with the studio teacher to ensure an appropriate level of difficulty. Substitutions are permitted with the instructor's permission. Two or three pieces shall be selected to contrast in style, and must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes. Scales and etudes will not be required for juries although they will be studied in lessons, and must be included in the student's daily practice routine.. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 2 M2920, M2921

In consultation with the studio teacher, students must prepare 3 pieces of repertoire – at least <u>one piece</u> from the following List of Required Works, and the others may be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List. Substitutions are permitted with the instructor's permission. All selected repertoire must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes.

Scales and etudes will not be required for juries. Students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical Evaluations will take place according to the regimen outlined in the Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". It is expected that scales and etudes will be a part of each student's practice routine, and technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 3 M3925

Repertoire shall be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List in consultation with the studio teacher to ensure an appropriate level of difficulty. Substitutions are permitted, with the instructor's permission. Two or three pieces should be selected to contrast in style, and must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes. Scales and etudes will not be required for juries, although they will be studied in lessons, and must be included in the student's daily practice routine. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 3 M3924y, M3929

Repertoire shall be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List in consultation with the studio teacher to ensure an appropriate level of difficulty. Substitutions are permitted, with the instructor's permission. All selected repertoire must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes (for M3924y, 15 minutes). Scales and etudes will not be required for juries; however, Technical Evaluations will take place in lessons and according to the regimen set out in the Course Syllabus.

Year 3 M3920

In consultation with the studio teacher, students must prepare 3 pieces of repertoire – at least <u>one piece</u> from the following list of Required Works, and the others may be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List. Substitutions are permitted with the instructor's permission. All selected repertoire must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes.

Scales and etudes will not be required for juries. Students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical Evaluations will take place according to the regimen outlined in the Course Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". It is expected that scales and etudes will be an integral part of each student's practice routine, and technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 3 M3921

The required work and orchestral excerpts must be prepared for the December jury (and amount to at least 10 minutes of music). A substitution for the required work may be used for transfer students, only with the permission of the studio instructor. Scales and etudes will not be required for this jury. Students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical evaluations will take place according to the regimen outlined in the Course Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". It is expected that scales and etudes will be an integral part of each student's practice routine, and technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

ORCHESTRAL EXCERPTS:

(Students should use volumes 1, 2, &3 of **Rothwell**, *Difficult Passages*, pub. Boosey and Hawkes, **or** *Orchestral Excerpts for Oboe*, edited by **John Ferrillo**, pub. Theodore Presser (one volume with piano accompaniment – recommended). Teacher will advise as to which passages to prepare.)

L.van Beethoven, Symphony #3, Eroica, 2nd mvt.
J. Brahms, Violin Concerto, opening, 2nd mvt.
M. Ravel, Le Tombeau de Couperin, 2 solos in 1st mvt.
P.I. Tchaikovsky, Symphony #4, opening of 2nd mvt.

RECITAL:

M3921 students are also required to give a recital (35 – 45 minutes of music, no intermission). Repertoire will be chosen in consultation with the studio teacher.

Year 3 M3922

Three pieces including the required work, and orchestral excerpts, must be prepared for the jury, (and the total playing time shall be not less than 20 minutes). A substitution for the required work may be used for transfer students, only with the permission of the studio instructor. Scales and etudes will not be required for juries; however, students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical evaluations will take place according to the regimen outlined in the Course Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". It is expected that scales and etudes will be an integral part of each student's practice routine, and technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

ORCHESTRAL EXCERPTS:

(Students should use either volumes 1, 2, &3 of **Rothwell**, *Difficult Passages*, pub. Boosey and Hawkes, **or** Orchestral Excerpts for Oboe, ed. John Ferrillo, pub. Theodore Presser (one volume with piano accompaniment – recommended). The studio teacher will advise as to which passages to prepare.)

L. van Beethoven, *Symphony #3, Eroica*, 2nd mvt. J. Brahms, *Violin Concerto*, opening 2nd mvt. Mendelssohn, *Symphony #3*, 2 solos in 2st mvt. P.I. Tchaikovsky, *Symphony #4*, opening 2nd mvt.

Year 4 M4925

Repertoire shall be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List in consultation with the studio teacher to ensure an appropriate level of difficulty. Substitutions are permitted, with the instructor's permission. Two or three pieces shall be selected to contrast in style, and must amount to a total playing time of not less than 20 minutes. Scales and etudes will not be required for juries: however, students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 4 M4924y, M4929

Repertoire shall be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List in consultation with the studio teacher to ensure an appropriate level of difficulty. Substitutions are permitted, with the instructor's permission. All selected repertoire must amount to a total playing time of not less than 30 minutes (for M4924y, 15 minutes). Scales and etudes will not be required for juries: however, students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical evaluations will take place according to the regimen as outlined in the Course Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". Technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

<u>Year 4</u> M4920

In consultation with the studio teacher, students must prepare 3 pieces of repertoire totaling at least 30 minutes of music – at least <u>one piece</u> from the following list of Required Works, and the others may be selected from the Oboe Repertoire List. Substitutions are permitted, with the instructor's permission.

Scales and etudes will not be required for juries; however, students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical evaluations will take place according to the regimen outlined in the Course Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". Technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

Year 4 M4921, M4922, M4923

The required work and orchestral excerpts must be prepared for a December jury, (preparing at least 10 minutes of music). A substitution for the required work may be used for transfer students, and only with the permission of the studio instructor. Scales and etudes will not be required for juries; however, students will be responsible for scale and etude preparation for lessons. Technical evaluations will take place according to the regimen outlined in the Course Syllabus under "Technique Evaluation". Technical evaluations will be factored into the end-of-year lesson mark. Specific requirements and times will be documented in the Course Syllabus.

ORCHESTRAL EXCERPTS:

(Students should use <u>either</u> volumes 1, 2, &3 of **Rothwell**, *Difficult Passages*, pub. Boosey and Hawkes, **or** *Orchestral Excerpts for Oboe*, ed. John Ferrillo, pub. Theodore Presser (one volume, with piano accompaniment – recommended). The studio teacher will advise as to which excerpts to prepare.

J. Brahms, Symphony #1 – 2nd movement
G. Rossini, Overture to "La Scala di Seta" – slow and fast solos
R. Strauss, Don Juan – opening to letter B and letter L to 2 bars after letter N
M. Ravel, Le Tombeau de Couperin, 1st movement (2 excerpts)

RECITAL:

M4921, M4922, and M4923 students are also required to give a recital. (M4921, M4923: 45-55 minutes of music, and M4922: 50 minutes of music)

Intermission for fourth year recitals is optional.
