* First year students must include 1.0 course from each of two of the three categories (A, B, and C). At least one course must be chosen from each of the three categories (A, B, and C) prior to graduation. No more than 7.0 full or equivalent courses numbered 1000-1999 may be used to fulfill degree requirements.

**A minimum of 7.5 Music elective courses must be completed for the module in Years 2 through 5 at the 2000 level or above.

A maximum of 1.0 courses from the former Music 2171a/b/y, Music 2801a/b and Music 2700a/b through Music 2709a/b/y may be counted toward the module.

Progression Requirements: Students in the combined program must meet the normal progression standards for both the Bachelor of Arts (Honours Specialization in Music) and HBA programs. Students enrolled in the HBA1 (Year 3) must attain a minimum weighted overall weighted average of at least 78%. In Years 4 and 5, students must attain a minimum weighted average of 75% in their 4000-level HBA2 courses. They must also maintain a minimum average of 70% with no grade less than 60% in the Music module, and a passing grade in each option.
