Admission requirements after Year II Music: Completion of all courses specified for Years I and II of the program; a cumulative weighted average of at least 70% in Music courses; no mark less than 60% in senior Music courses, a passing grade in each non-Music course; a mark of at least 70% in Music 1802A/B and Music 2831a/b and 2832a/b or courses chosen from Music 2861a/b through Music 2881a/b and 2873Q/R/S/T and 2880Q/R/S/T. **Progression Requirements:** Completion of the previous year's approved program of study with a weighted average of at least 70% and no grade less than 60% in Music courses, and a passing grade in each non-Music elective.
